

We recommended that public transport is used as parking facilities are limited.

## By car

### From Paris/Mâcon

Take the A6 towards Lyon, then go through the Fourvière Tunnel. Take the A7 towards Marseille then turn off at exit 1 (Geneva /Grenoble /Gerland /Charlemagne). Cross the Pasteur Bridge and take Avenue Tony Garnier.

### From Vienne/Valence/St Etienne/Clermont Ferrand

Take the A7 towards Lyon.

Take the Grenoble /Chambéry/Bourg-en-Bresse/St-Fons/Bd-Périphérique exit on to the N383 then follow the signs towards the Stade de Gerland [Gerland Stadium]/Lyon Centre.

### From Grenoble/ Lyon Saint Exupéry Airport/Chambéry/ Annecy

Take the A43 towards Lyon.

Take the St. Etienne/ Marseille/Périphérique Sud

exit on to the N383. Then take the Paris/Lyon Centre/Gerland exit and follow the signs towards the Stade de Gerland/ Lyon Centre.

### From Geneva

Take the A42 towards Lyon. After the Beynost toll, take the turning to Marseille/Lyon/Rocade-Est then go towards Lyon/Bd-Périphérique. Follow the Périphérique Sud/Marseille/Grenoble signs on to the N383.

Take the Paris/Lyon-Centre/Gerland exit then follow the signs towards the Stade de Gerland/ Lyon-Centre.

## By public transport

### From Lyon Saint Exupéry Airport

- Take the Rhônexpress Express Tram from Saint Exupéry Airport to Part-Dieu or Jean Macé stations (every 20 mins).

(Express Tram travel time approx. 30 min)

- Take metro line B heading in the direction of Gare d'Oullins. Get off at Stade de Gerland. (Metro travel time approx. 20 min + 10 min walk)

### From Part-Dieu station

- Take metro line B heading in the direction of Gare d'Oullins. Get off at Stade de Gerland. (Metro travel time approx. 20 min + 10 min walk)

### From Lyon Perrache station

- Take tram T1 towards Debourg. Get off at Halle Tony Garnier.
- Take Avenue Tony Garnier. (Tram travel time approx. 9 min + 10 min walk)

or

- Take bus number 60 in the direction of Feyzin. Les Razes. Get off at Institut Pasteur. (Bus travel time approx. 10 min)
